

Father Antony, popularly known as 'Missionary of Chelakkara', was declared Servant of God by the Vatican, June 9, 2009. Archbishop Andrews Thazhath of Thrissur made the announcement at St. Mary's Forane Church at Chelakkara on 9th June 2009.

Venerated as the "Father of the Poor", Bro. Fortunatus died in Kattappanaat the age of 87. Brother Thanheuser was made Servant of God on November 22 at Kattappana in Idukki district. Bishop Mathew Arackal of Kanjirapally was the main celebrant of a Solemn High Mass at St. George Forane Church in Kattappana.
