To be beatified, a miracle (usually involving a medically unexplainable cure attributed to prayers asking his intercession, that took place after his death and after the opening of his cause, and which must be verified by a panel of doctors and another panel of theologians, before it is finally approved by the Congregation and the Pope) would have to happen. After beatification, another such miracle would have to happen and be similarly approved if he is to be canonized as a saint.



'Marykunju' second of seven children of Paily and Eliswa in the Vattalil family committed herself to the service of God and humanity on 1st May 1974 and took the name 'Sr. Rani Maria'. Realizing her great missionary zeal she was sent to Bijnor mission in U.P. in 1976. In 1992 Sr. Rani Maria arrived at Udainagar, Indore, M.P. after 16 years of dedicated missionary work with a reputation of being a very committed social worker, organizer and animator. On 25th February 1995, when Sr. Rani Maria was on her way to Bhopal to go to Kerala, she was assaulted in a local bus and was killed by Samandar Singh. She was beatified in Indore on 4 November 2017.

A London-born teenager - whose proficiency at spreading the teachings of the Catholic church online led to him being called "God's influencer" - is set to become a saint.

Carlo Acutis died in 2006, at the age of 15, meaning he would be the first millennial - a person born in the early 1980s to late 1990s - to be canonised. He was declared "Blessed," by Francis on October 10, 2020. The second miracle was approved by the Pope following a meeting with the Vatican's saint-making department.
